How to Enrol

To avoid disappointment, we recommend that you enrol as soon as possible. For your convenience there are a number of ways to enrol:

in person at the Campus most convenient to you.

by post

- The Postal Enrolment form can be downloaded from the NRC website www.nrc.ac.uk or can be requested at any campus reception, and must be used for postal enrolment and returned to your local campus.
- Please do not enclose cash. Cheques should be made payable to Northern Regional College.
- Postal enrolment is not available to those who are eligible for reduced fees or when fees are paid by an employer or other body.
- Postal enrolment cannot be accepted for courses requiring an interview.
- Please note that if specific course entry requirements have not been met before the course commences, the postal enrolment is void and fees will be returned.

by telephone

- The College can accept telephone credit/debit card enrolments at any Campus reception.
- Telephone enrolments are only

available to those students paying the full tuition fee

You can enrol at any campus from Monday to Thursday, 9am to 4pm and on Friday 9am to 3pm. A copy of the enrolment form can be downloaded from the NRC website www.nrc.ac.uk or can be requested at any campus reception.

Is an interview required?

Although we operate on a first come first served basis and advise early enrolment to secure a place, please note that some courses may require an interview prior to enrolment. For further information please contact Admissions at your local Campus.

Do I need to wait for my examination results?

Where a course has a formal entry requirement, it is not necessary to wait for the results of examinations before applying. Places can be offered provisionally pending the publication of examination results.

What if I need advice?

Returning to college, perhaps after a gap in formal education can lead to specific needs for advice and support. Student Support on each campus can provide information on a variety of issues including financial support and careers advice and guidance. If you require individual careers guidance we can offer a free, confidential guidance service.

Unique Learner Numbers

As of September 2009 Northern Regional College will obtain Unique Learner Numbers for students enrolled at the college registering with awarding bodies. The Unique Learner Number (ULN) is issued by Managing Information Across Partners (MIAP). MIAP offer a Learner Record Service which will permit anyone with a ULN to access their participation and achievement data via a website. A pilot of this website will commence in England in September 2009 and will eventually be rolled out across England, Wales and Northern Ireland.

If the course you enrol on requires registration with an awarding body you will be asked to complete a document called a Fair Processing Notice as part of the enrolment process.

Financial Information

Fees Information

Please note that all fees to be paid at time of enrolment.

Fees indicated in this guide apply only to UK residents and those having EEA Migrant Worker status. Those who are not in these categories must contact Student Services for the appropriate fee.

Tuition fees are payable every year of a two or three year programme and may vary depending on the fee set for any particular year.

Some tuition fees include a Franchise Fee which is payable by the College to the University of Ulster. Where a student is entitled to a reduction in tuition fees or is paying by instalments, the Franchise Fee must be paid in full by its due date.

Some courses may involve additional costs eg assessment fees, residential costs or material charges. Applicants are advised to check if any of these apply to their course.

Methods of Payment

Fees may be paid by cheque, credit/debit cards. We also accept cash payments for enrolments, but only in person to the Receptionist.

Reduced Fees

Concessionary rates for tuition fees may be claimed by applicants in the following categories:

Students in receipt of:-

- Income based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income Support
- Working Tax Credit (**with NHS Exemption and income threshold £16,000**)
- Child Tax Credit (**income threshold £16,000**)
- Pension Credit
- Rates Relief
- Other means tested benefit

Non-means tested benefits (in isolation) eg Disability Living Allowance or Incapacity Benefit are not eligible for concessionary fees.

Supporting evidence ie documentary evidence from the Social Security Agency (SSA) issuing office eg a letter of current entitlement to benefit must be made available by the applicant for inspection and/or photocopying by the administrator collecting their fees.

Full time students (Proof of full-time study eg a current student identity card must be available for inspection).

The **concessionary rate is determined as 50% of the standard rate** for the course, subject to a minimum concessionary fee of £25.00 per course.

Financial Information

Refunds

1 All courses:

a Course cancelled by Northern Regional College **Full tuition fee refund**

b Student withdrawal before course start date **Full tuition fee refund**

2 Courses already commenced:

a Student withdrawing within 2 weeks of course start date **Full refund of tuition fee paid to date less £10 administration fee**

A Refund Request Form must be received by the College on or before 14 days after the start of the course.

b Students withdrawing after 2 weeks and up to and including the 6th week **50% of tuition fee due**

c Students withdrawing after the 15th week **Credit note for 50% of tuition fee due**

d Students withdrawing after 15 weeks **No refund**

3 Examination entry fees prior to forwarding to Awarding Body **Full refund**

Where the examination fee has been forwarded to the Awarding Body the student must contact the Awarding Body directly.

Requests for refunds must be received in writing from the student on the designated refund form. No form is required where the College cancels the programme.

* Credit notes are non-transferable and are to be used within the current or following academic year of issue.

Financial Information

Financial Support

The Northern Regional College recognises that for some students, the cost of travel or childcare, for example, may stop you from joining or continuing on a course or programme.

The Student Finance Team can give you advice on financial matters and help you to apply for any appropriate grants or awards that are available.

Part-time Higher Education students, who are studying at least 50% of an equivalent full-time course, can apply for financial help. Your entitlement will depend on your income and that of your spouse/partner. Student Finance NI will work out how much support you can get.

Purpose of Fund

The purpose of the Support Fund (Discretionary) is to provide help to students facing financial difficulty and to assist access and participation in further education.

Assistance from the Support Fund may be available to students who are over 18, or become 18 during the academic year.

All Full-time and Part-time Further Education Students who wish to apply for support funds in the coming year, **must** apply in the first instance to the Western Education and Library Board.

Library Service

With seven libraries across the college, the library service aims to support your course needs by offering a comprehensive collection of resources and facilities together with experienced staff who are happy to help and advise you. Library materials cover a wide range of subjects in a variety of media - print, electronic and audio-visual. E-resources include collections of full text periodicals and newspapers, reference books, subject specific databases and relevant websites.

The computers in the libraries may be used for study related activities and the preparation of coursework. All computers are equipped with Microsoft Office software and allow free access to the Internet. Printers, scanners and photocopiers are available for student use.

In order to make use of these facilities you must register in the library on the site where you are studying but subsequently you will be welcome to use any of the college libraries and an inter-library book loan service is available.
